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ITINERARY:

Highlights: Two Casinos, Unparalleled Spectacular Scenery, 1 lunch, Jet boat ride on the Snake River, Wallowa Lake Tramway, Grand Coulee Dam Tour, Spokane City Tour, Shopping in Spokane.



Day 1: Welcome aboard! Luxury awaits you! Today as we head south, we'll travel on the Crowsnest Pass before crossing the United States border at Kingsgate and then into Bonners Ferry where you can try your luck in the casino. Overnight: Bonners Ferry, Idaho

Day 2: Beautiful summer scenery awaits us as head south crossing Lake Pend Oreille. Some folks say big ol' Lake Pend Oreille is Idaho's most magnificent lake. It's the state's largest (43 miles long, 111 miles of shoreline). It's the deepest (at 1,158 feet

deep, there are only four deeper lakes in the nation, Crater lake Oregon 1949 feet, Lake Tahoe, 1644feet, and Lake Chelan, Washington 1419feet). We'll skirt the western border of Idaho before we conclude our day along the banks of the Salmon River. The Salmon is also known as The River of No Return. It flows for 425 miles (684 km) through central Idaho, draining 14,000 square miles and dropping more than 7,000 vertical feet between its headwaters above the Sawtooth Valley and its confluence with the Snake River. Overnight: Riggins Idaho.



Day 3: What a fun day today will be! We'll enter Hells Canyon, North America's deepest river gorge, which encompasses a vast and remote region with dramatic changes in elevation, terrain, climate and vegetation. Carved by the great Snake River, Hells Canyon plunges more than a mile below Oregon's west rim, and 8,000 feet below snow-capped He Devil Peak of Idaho's Seven Devils Mountains. What fun as we go for a jet boat ride on the Snake River! The scenery will be unparalleled! For added fun, wear something that you can get wet in. Lunch will be included, and we will overnight in the little town of Halfway, Oregon.

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Day 4: Wow! The spectacular scenery continues to surround us as we drive through some extremely beautiful United States Forest Service Roads on our way to Spokane. We'll stop near Joseph Oregon and experience magnificent views from the summit of the 3700' vertical foot ascent to the summit of Mt. Howard. The exciting trip to the top of the mountain allows one to enjoy the view as the gondola rises above the Wallowa Lake Village and the blue waters of Wallowa Lake. Overnight Spokane

Day 5: After all the excitement of the Snake River, we'll have a guided City tour of Spokane, then we'll turn you loose to shop as wild as the water of the Snake River within a popular shopping mall! Overnight Spokane

Day 6: As we head north, we'll stop at the Grand Coulee Dam to learn about 8th Wonder of the World! At almost a mile long, Grand Coulee Dam is a hydroelectric gravity dam on the Columbia River in the U.S. state of Washington. It is the largest electric power producing facility and the largest concrete structure in the United States. After a tour of the Dam, we'll continue north crossing the border at Osoyoos and proceeding to Vernon for the night.



Day 7: From Vernon, it will be a short and beautiful drive to the very picturesque and beautiful chalet of Three Valley Gap for the night.

Day 8: full day, we're homeward bound, and we will cherish the fun memories of our snake river jet boat ride as well as the new friendships we've made! What a great tour this has been!

To help you enjoy a safe and relaxing holiday, we remind you of the following:

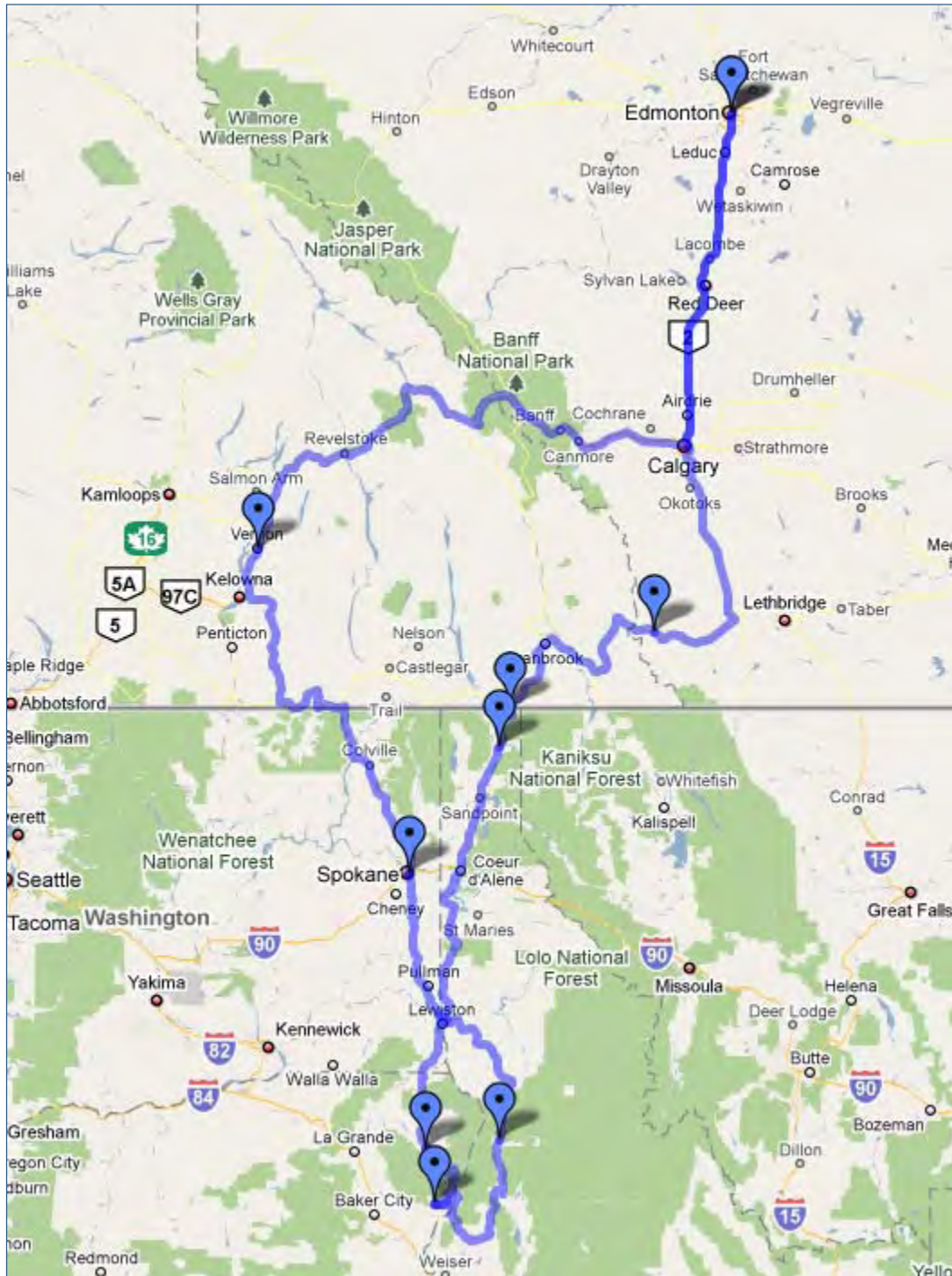
- The medical information and liability waiver must be completed to assist you in the event of an emergency. Bring this form when first boarding the coach.

- We clearly tag your baggage for easy handling and identification. In order to accommodate all passengers, we ask that you restrict luggage to one large suitcase (for hotel staff to handle) and one carry on bag (that is your responsibility) per person.
- In order to keep the coach clean and neat, and for your comfort, we ask that you refrain from eating and drinking (except water!) on the coach. Our frequent stops (every 2-3 hours) allow plenty of opportunity for filling our tummies.
- If you are diabetic, or have a medical condition that requires food more often, let us know. We'll be pleased to meet your needs.
- While your rooms, tours and special events are included, in order to accommodate the variety of individual tastes, meals are your responsibility. We endeavour to arrange suitable eating establishments en route – enjoy!
